#### Hello everyone.

I love ramen and I think many of you might like ramen too. Today, I want to talk about why ramen has become a "Japanese dish" and has even come to be (①) as a "national dish".

Ramen has its roots in China, but the reason why it has become loved by many Japanese people is that it has taken inspiration from the traditional Chinese style and modified it for Japanese tastes. (②) types of ramen have been developed using different noodle sizes, shapes, ingredients and soup seasonings. Another reason why ramen is loved in Japan is that in 1958 the world's first (③) noodle "Nissin Chicken Ramen" was released by Mr. Momofuku Ando, to great success, spreading all over Japan.

In 1992, a ramen chain restaurant in the Hokuriku region expanded overseas, but at firstit simply did not have a good reputation because the ramen quality was not very good. In
the 2000s, ramen craftsmen and food producers who worked in popular restaurants
conducted thorough (4) in order to learn about the tastes of people in other countries.
Based on the taste that many Japanese people like, they offered ramen that attracted people
in other countries, and this was a big hit in many places. One American left a review, "A
little expensive, but high quality and the taste is worth the price."

I think the possibilities of Japanese ramen are endless. We must not forget that there are creators who spare no (⑤) to create better things now and in the past, and I learned again the importance of continuing to improve.
