Hello everyone.

Do you know of the "Yosakoi Soran" Festival? It is an event held in Sapporo every year in (①) June. Many teams of up to 150 people perform the dances that they have created at 25 different venues in Sapporo City.

There are only two basic rules to join the festival. The first is to dance with "Naruko" in your hands. Naruko was originally used by hanging it in the fields to (②) away birds with the sound it makes. Since it was incorporated into dances at the Yosakoi Festival in Kochi prefecture, it has now become an indispensable symbolic instrument at Yosakoi related festivals nationwide.

The (③) rule is to put the phrase of "Soran Bushi" in the song you play during the dance. It is one of the Hokkaido folk songs. It refers to a labor song (④) by fishermen in Hokkaido when fishing for herring in the past. Used in tune with the song "Yahlensorlan", it expresses the power of fishing. Other than that, the dances, songs, costumes, etc. are up to the teams.

The festival, which began 30 years ago with 1,000 participants from 10 teams and 200,000 spectators, has spread not only in Hokkaido, but also (⑤) Japan and overseas, and has grown into a festival with 27,000 participants from about 270 teams and about 2 million spectators.

I love dancing at the festival, so when I become a university student, I want to become a member of the student executive committee and contribute more to the development of this festival.
